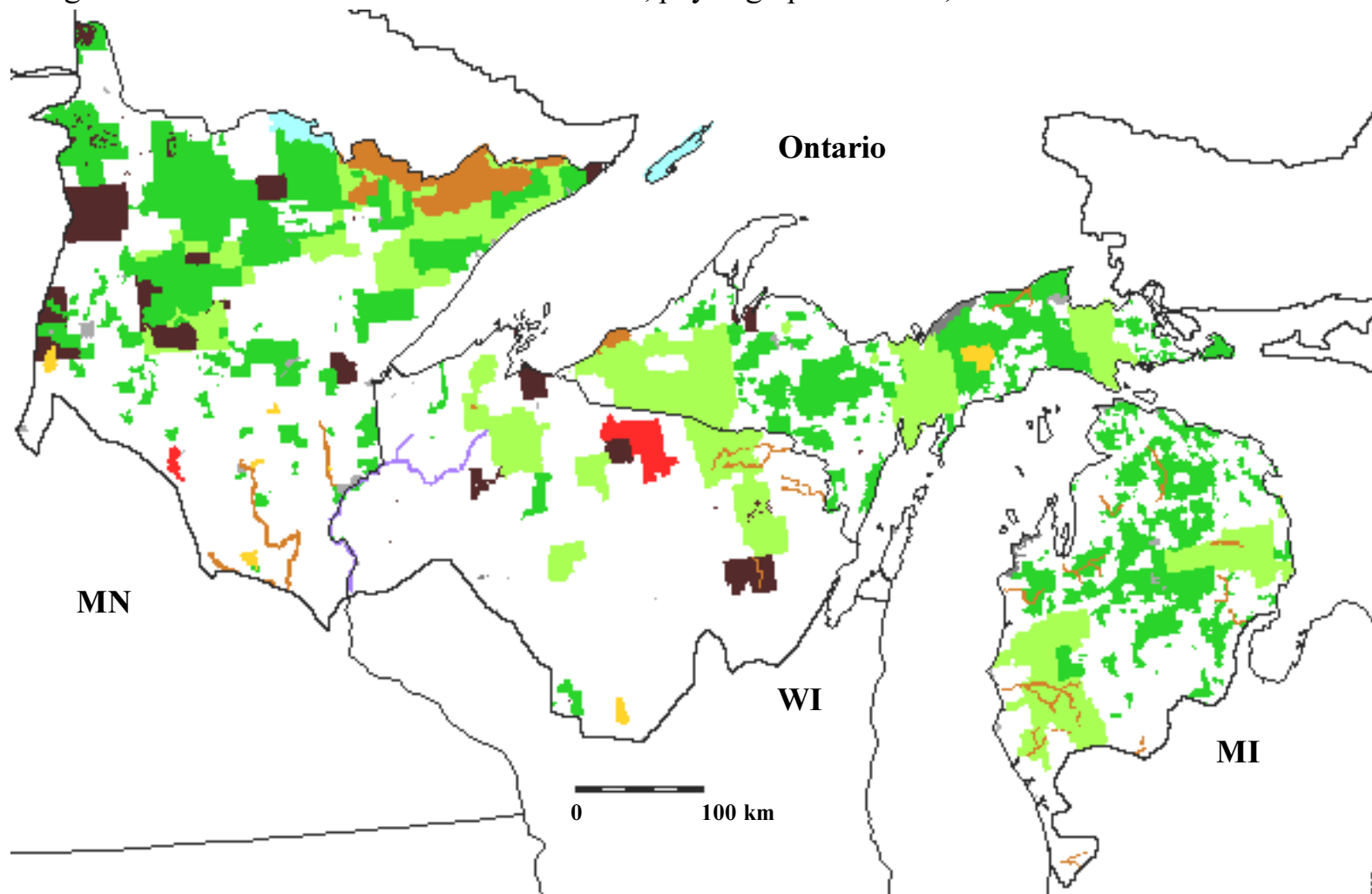

















Managed lands in the Boreal Hardwood Transition, physiographic area 20, from UC Santa Barbara database
