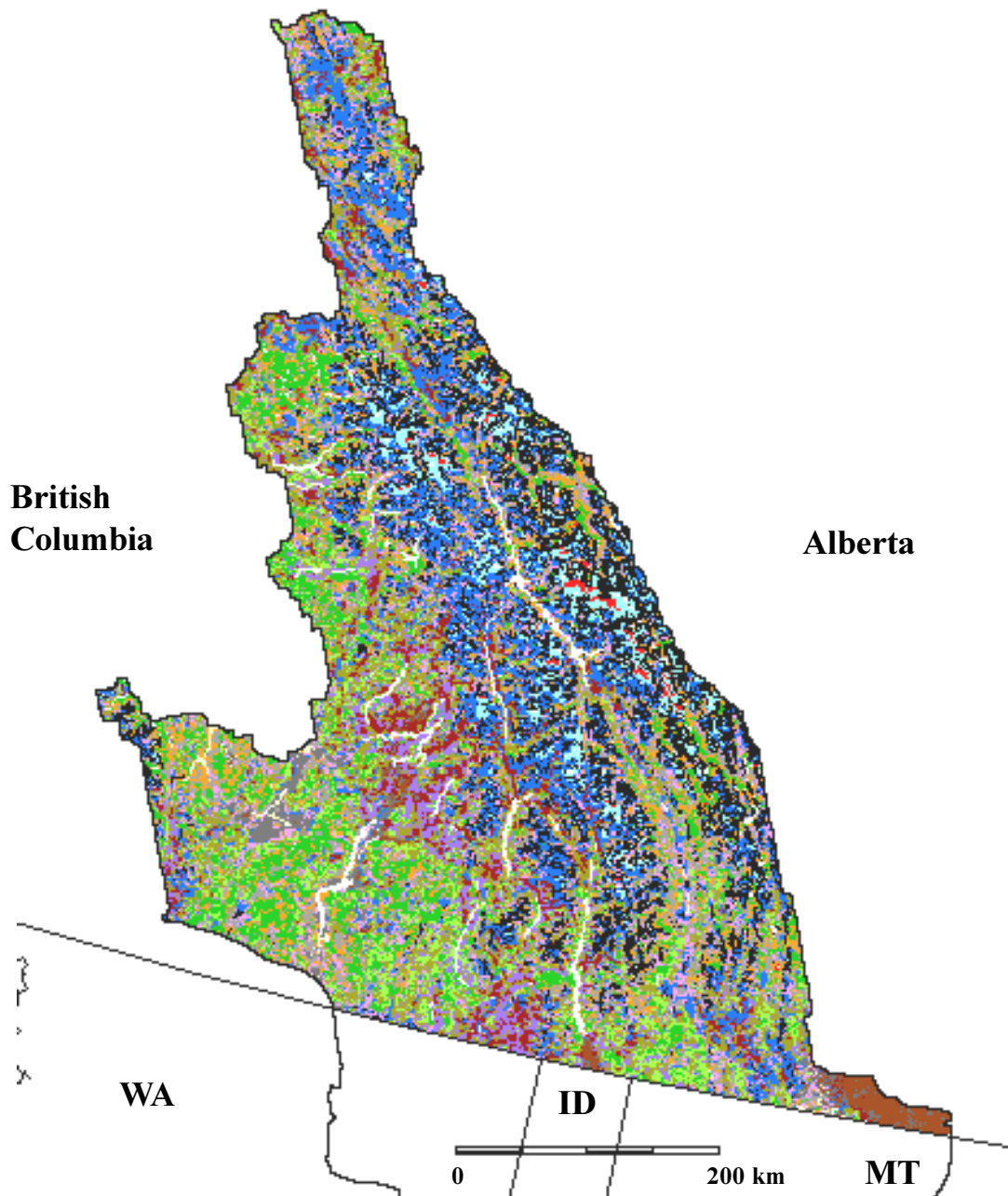

















Forest and nonforest cover types in the Canadian portion of the Central Rocky Mountains, physiographic area 64, from CCRS data
