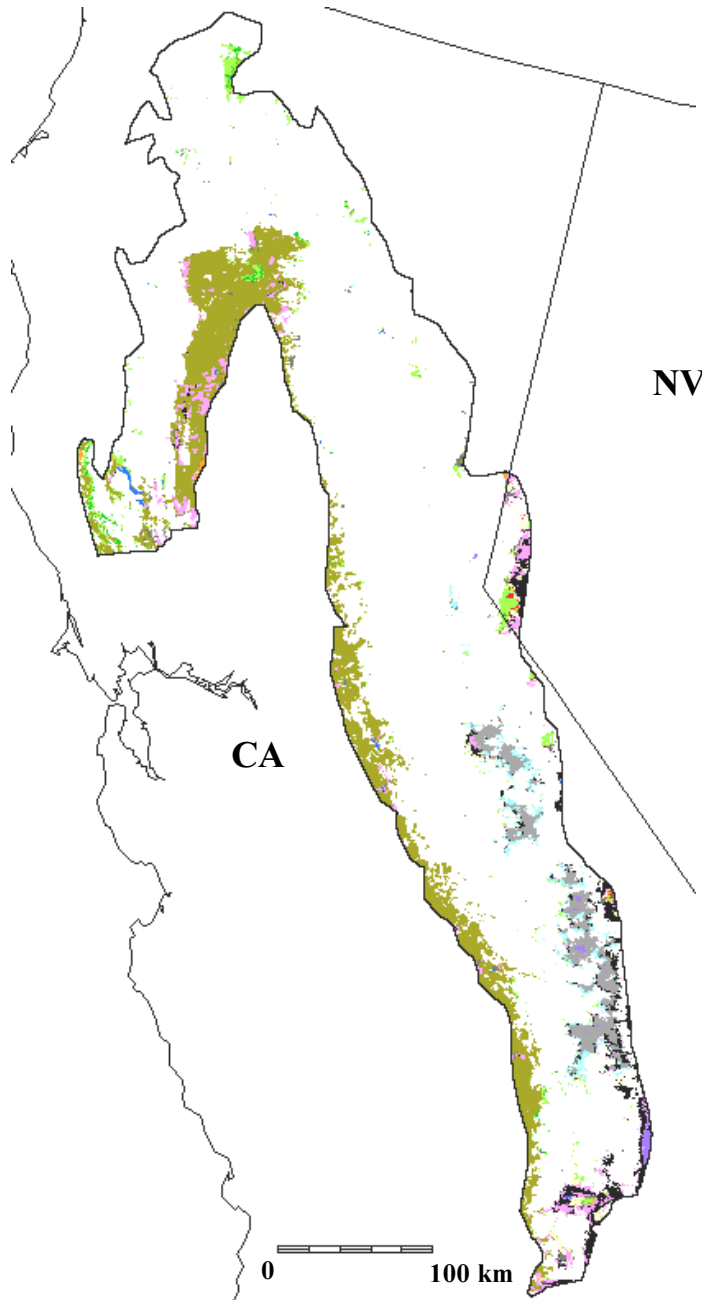

















Forest and nonforest cover types in the Sierra Nevada, physiographic area 66, modified from USGS data.
