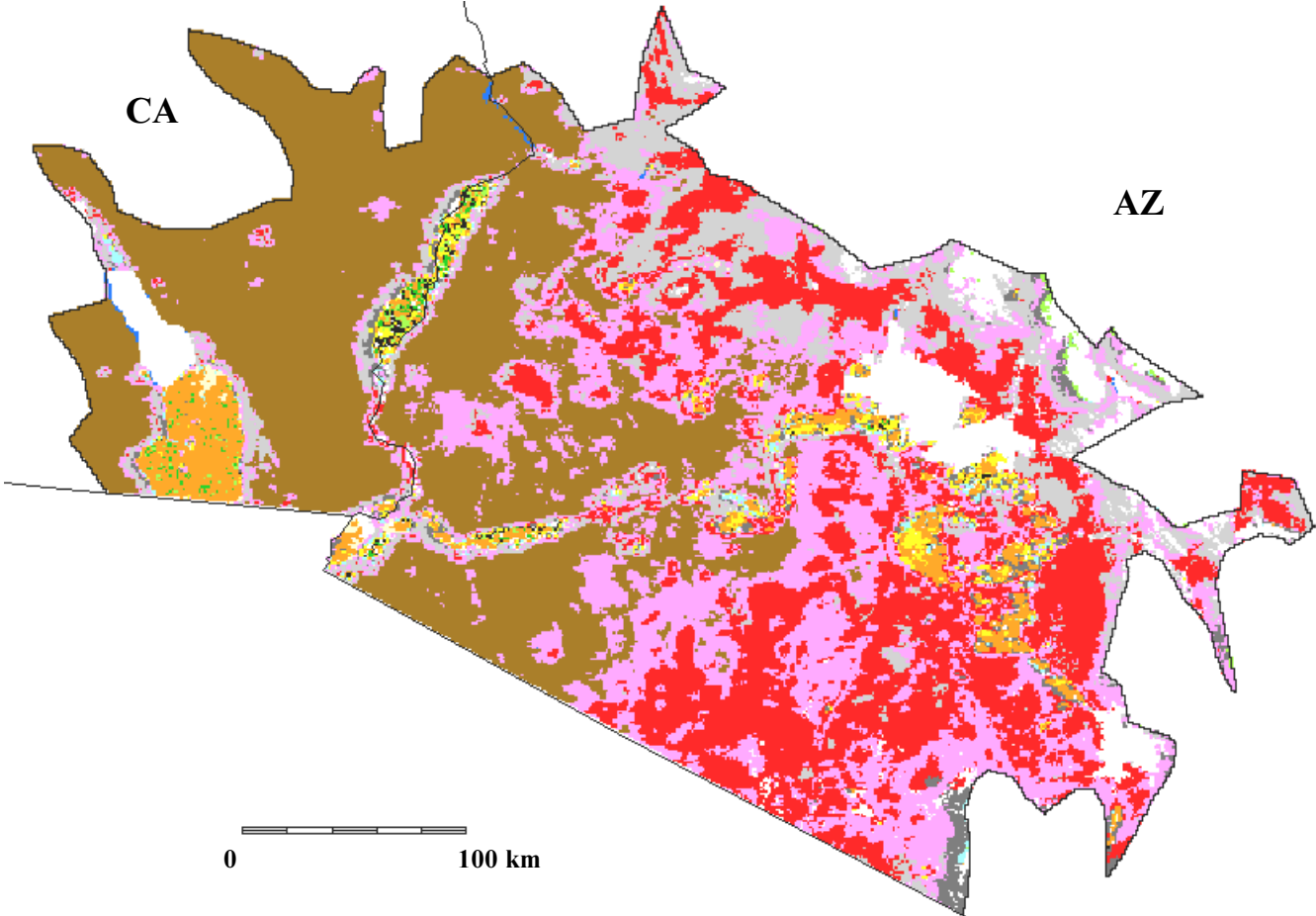

















Forest and nonforest cover types in the Sonoran Desert, physiographic area 82, modified from USGS data.
