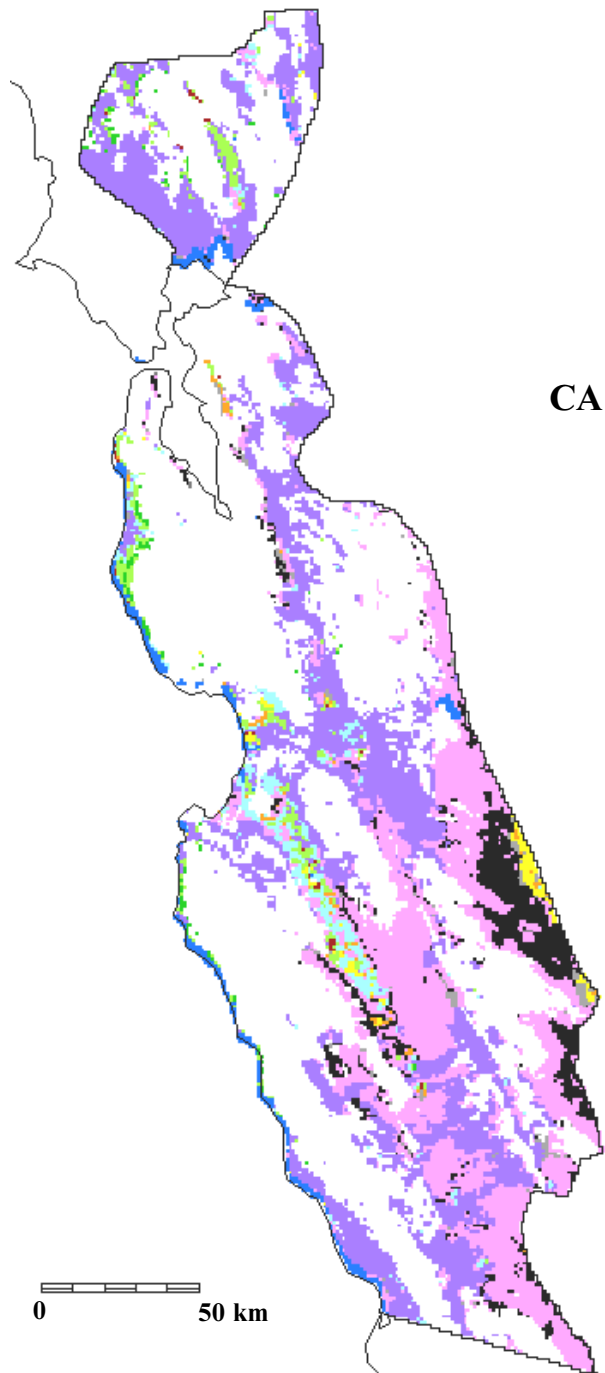















Forest and nonforest cover types in the California Foothills, physiographic area 92, modified from USGS data.
