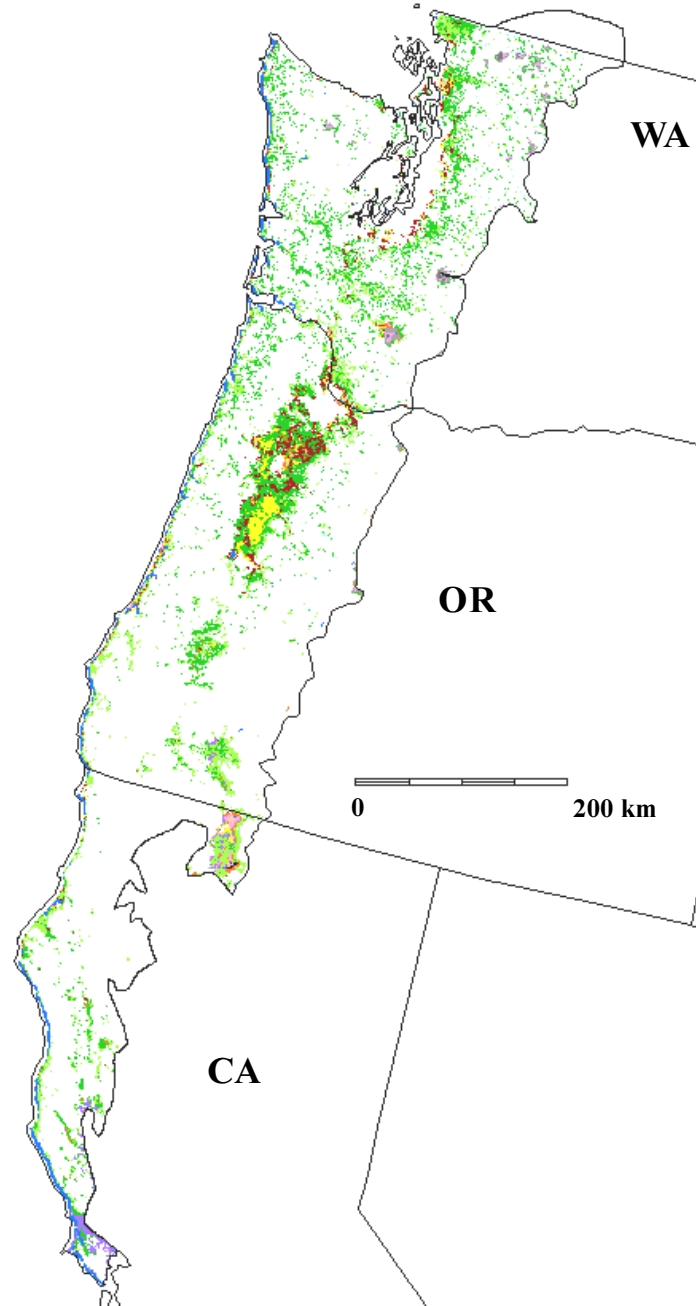


















Forest and nonforest cover types in the U.S. portion of the Southern Pacific Rainforests, physiographic area 93, modified from USGS data
