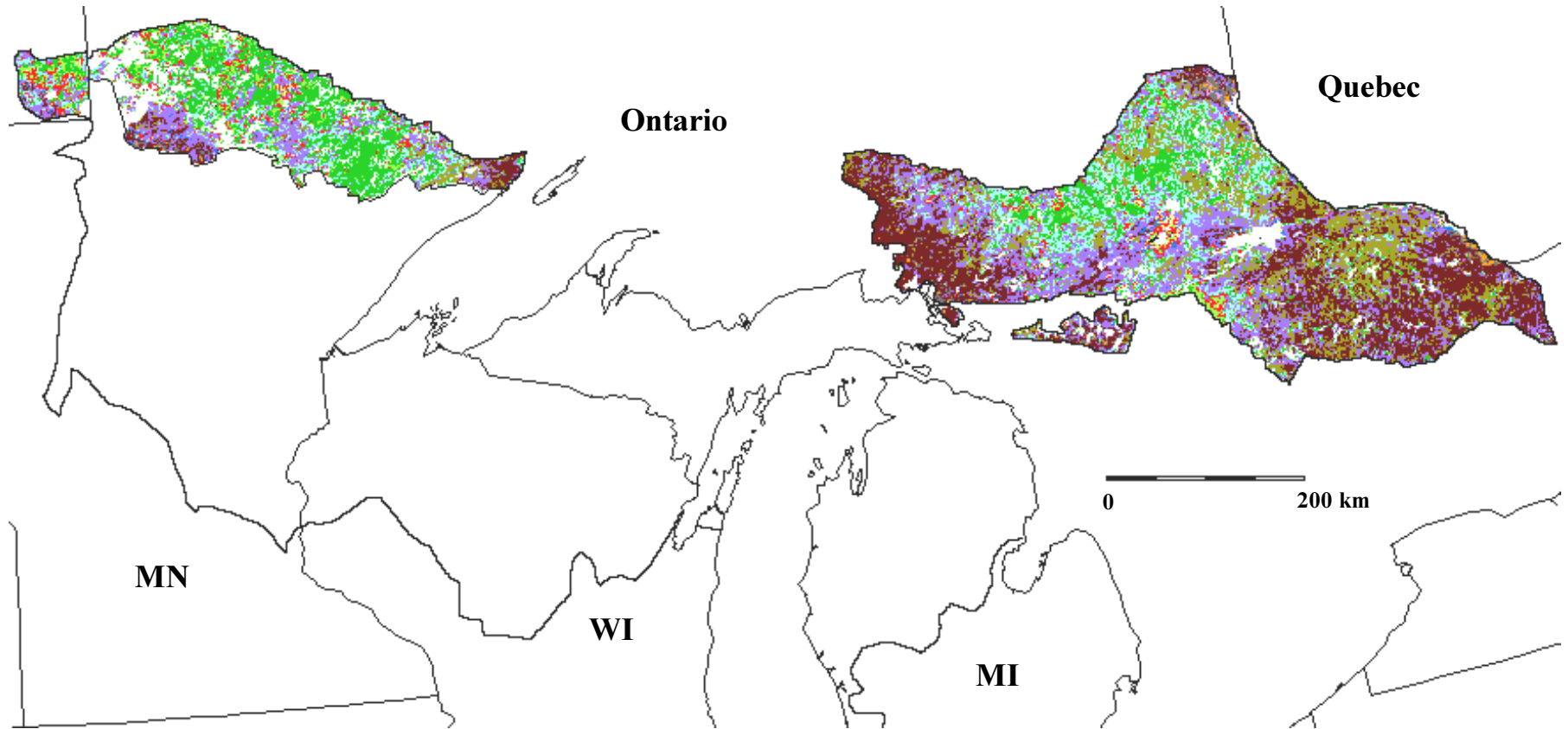
















Forest types in the Canadian portion of the Boreal Hardwood Transition, physiographic area 20, from CCRS data
