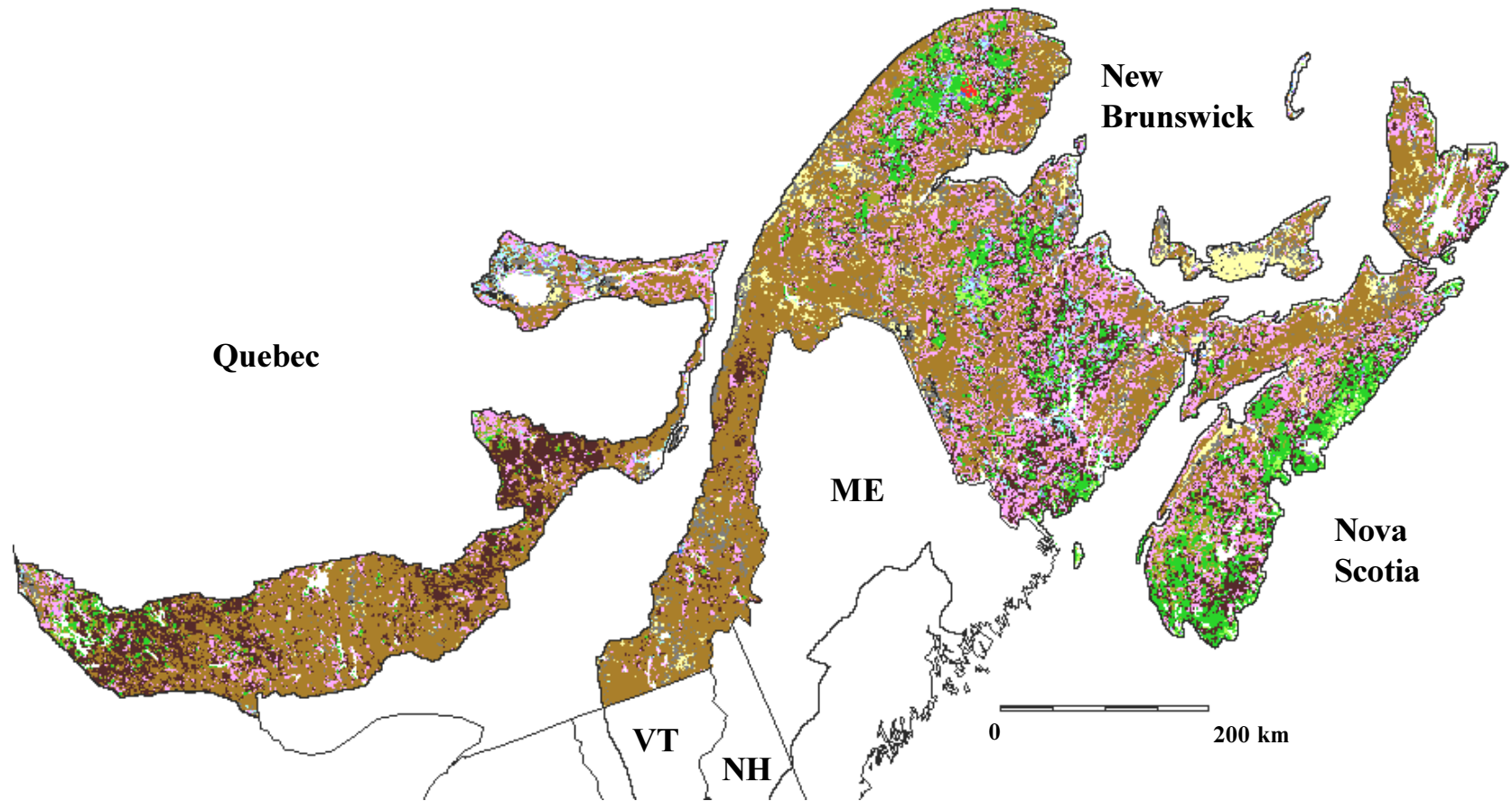


















Forest types in the Canadian portion of the Eastern Spruce-Hardwood Forest, physiographic area 28, from CCRS data
