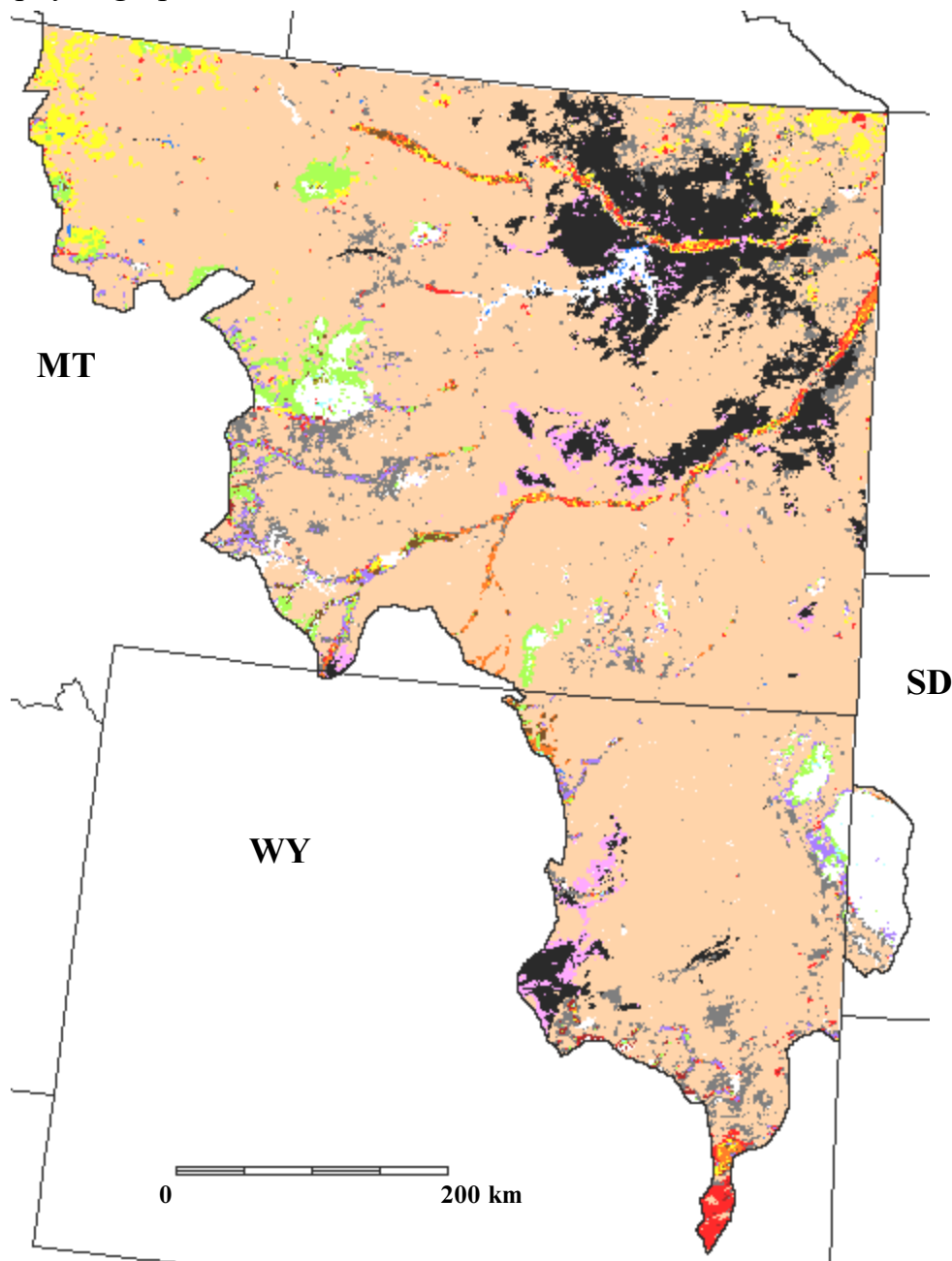



















Forest and nonforest cover types in the U.S. portion of the Northern Shortgrass Prairie, physiographic area 39, modified from USGS data.
