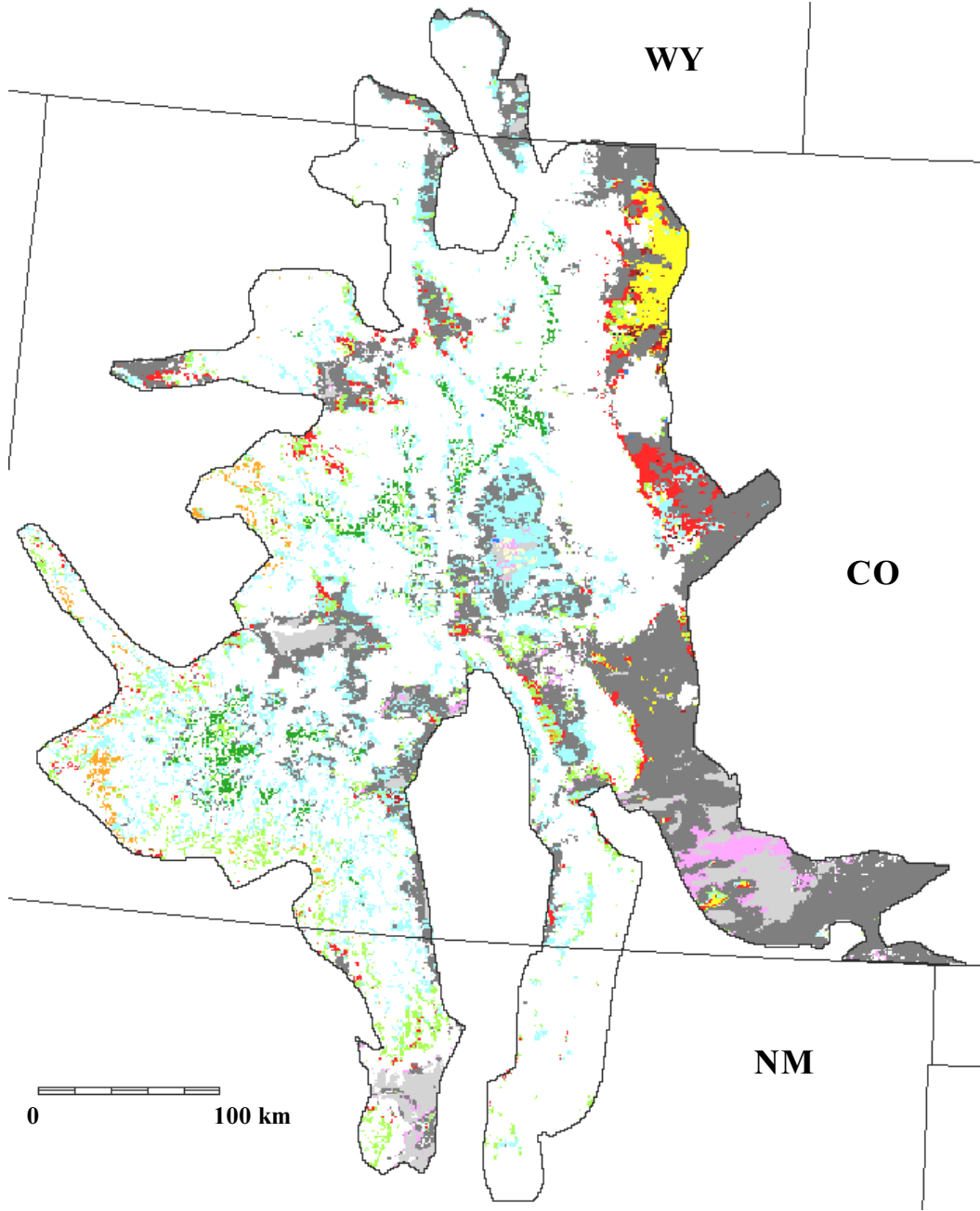
















Forest and nonforest cover types in the Southern Rocky Mountains, physiographic area 62, modified from USGS data.
