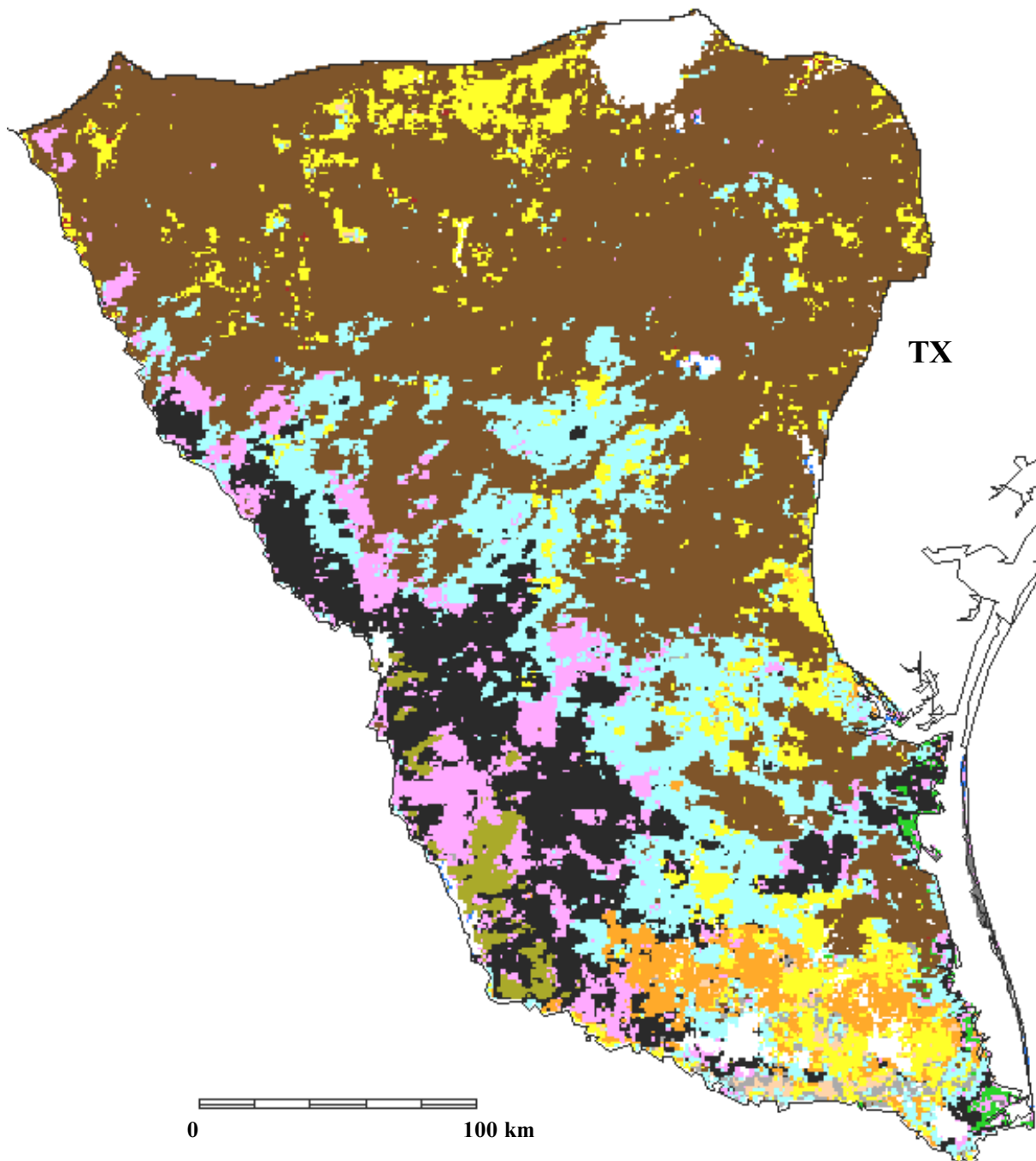
















Nonforest cover types in the South Texas Brushlands, physiographic area 7, modified from USGS data.
